**C. R. M. (A) 4502 of 2024**

In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Krishnanagar Women Police Station Case No. 92 of 2024 dated 28.09.2024 under Sections 85/123/109 of BNS.

1. Petitioner no. 1 is the mother-in-law and petitioner no. 2 is the uncle-in-law of the *de facto* complainant-housewife. They contended there was matrimonial discord. *De facto* complainant had misbehaved with her father-in-law and others. As a result her father-in-law died. She was arrested. Subsequently, they have been falsely implicated.

2. Learned Advocate for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

3. We have considered the materials on record. Allegation of administration of poison is not supported by medical evidence. It is contended there was a skirmish between *de facto* complainant and the in-laws. At that stage, her father-in-law died. She was

arrested. Possibility of false implication owing to matrimonial discord cannot be ruled out.

4. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail.

5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., **(1) Reba Saha** and **(2) Raja Roy Chowdhury** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

6. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
