C. R. M. (A) 4515 of 2024

In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Asansol (South) Police Station Case No. 424 of 2024 dated 23.11.2024 under Section 318 of the BNS 2023 and Sections 63/65 of the Indian Copy Right Act, 1957.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Alleged deceptively similar commodity has already been seized. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner for progress of investigation is not necessary.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
