1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner is the mother-in-law of the victim. It is contended victim’s wife had an illicit relationship. As a result, he committed suicide.
3. Keeping in mind the role of the petitioner in the crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to her.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. She shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
