1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners are the parents and sister of the principal accused who is in custody. Principal accused had promised to marry the victim but later he demanded money and refused to marry her. As a result, victim committed suicide.
3. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to them.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
