The present revisional application has been preferred praying for quashing of the proceedings in Special Case No. 222 of 2018 corresponding to Complaint Case No. 460 of 2017 under Sections 500/501/502/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Special Judge (MP & MLA Court), Barasat.
