1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the material on record. Allegations of torture are general and omnibus. Medical report does not show that the injuries are grievous. Assault is not attributable to the petitioner-husband.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
5. Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
6. The application being CRM (A) 421 of 2024 is disposed of.
