Although, the petitioner was initially praying for registration of the appeal under the provisions of the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 upon furnishing a bank guarantee, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner would deposit the amount required for registration of the appeal as the appeal needs to be heard out.
