Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner had made an application for compassionate appointment. It appears from the report of the State that they have forwarded his claims to the said Chairman of the Regional School Service Commission.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State relies on the report filed earlier and submits the application of the petitioner along with a report has been submitted to the Chairman, RSSC Hill Region vide memo no. 193/DI/SE/KPG dated 25.07.2024.

As the State has already forwarded the petitioner's prayer for compassionate appointment

before the concerned respondent authority being the Chairman of the RSSC, no further order need be passed in this regard.

However, the Chairman RSSC shall consider the proposal for compassionate appointment in accordance with law and expeditiously, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
