1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner is in custody for 95 days. Investigation is complete. Whether injuries are life threatening or not requires to be assessed during trial.
3. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion further detention of the petitioner for progress of investigation is not necessary and he may be enlarged on bail.
4. Accordingly, the petitioner **Jatindra Rakshit @ Jatindra Rakhkhit** viz., shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

6. This application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
