Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the writ petition upon Mr. Saikat Banerjee, learned advocate who usually represents the West Bengal Board of Primary Education before the Court. The Secretary of the Board is directed to regularize the engagement of Mr. Saikat Banerjee.

The application filed by the petitioner seeking transfer on medical ground is pending consideration at the end of the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education.

Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education to consider the said application in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of ninety

days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner immediately thereafter.

Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to forward a copy of the application seeking transfer along with all documents in support of her prayer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
