The petitioner prays for grant of bail on the ground of prolonged detention. The petitioner submits that 18 witnesses have been cited in the charge-sheet, but not a single witness has yet been examined.

Learned Advocates for the State produces the case diary.

We have considered the post mortem report and the contents of the case diary. We also find that there is an eye-witness.

Under such circumstances, the prayer for bail is rejected.

The learned trial court is requested to expedite the trial.
The State is directed to cooperate with the trial court for early
