The Court: The application has been filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.

This is an application seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal to conclude the arbitral proceedings.

It is submitted on behalf of both parties that this is the first extension sought for by the parties.
