The petitioner is a secured creditor. The petitioner has moved this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India challenging the delay on the part of the District Magistrate, Nadia in disposing of the application under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

The prayer of the petitioner is innocuous. An application was filed on January 19, 2024. No hearing has yet taken place.
