The Court: The interim order which has been passed by a predecessor Judge is well reasoned. There has not been any appeal therefrom. An arbitrator has been appointed.

Under such circumstances, the interim order will continue for a period of three months. In the meantime, the petitioner will approach the learned arbitrator by filing an application under Section 17 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996b with interim prayers. The learned arbitrator is requested to decide the scope of the interim prayers made

and dispose of the application within the aforesaid period of three months independently, without being influenced by the observations made in the order dated July 19, 2024 passed in AP-COM/695/2024.

Accordingly, AP-COM/695/2024 is disposed of.
