The Court: Ms. Sananda Ganguli, learned counsel, is appearing for the petitioner.

The Registrar Insolvency has submitted the report wherein it is indicated that the petitioner has rectified the defects as noted by the department.

The petitioner has filed the present application for grant of Letters of Administration in respect of the estate of the deceased. The deceased died on 4th February, 2008 and the wife of the deceased died on 21st May, 2011 leaving behind three legal heirs as reflected in paragraph 6 of the instant application. Out of three heirs, one is the petitioner who has applied for grant of Letters of Administration and the other two heirs have filed their consent for grant of Letters of Administration to the petitioner.
