Heard learned counsel for the parties. The arbitral proceeding in question has virtually been concluded and the award is about to be passed. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, as reflected from the last minutes of the arbitral proceeding, the parties are in mediation, for which an extension of six months of the mandate is prayed for.
