- (iii) A.P.O.T. No. 300 of 2023 [Machinery Agencies (India) & Another Vs. Abhinandan Chopra & Chopra];”

We record the above and on the joint prayer of the parties the applications AP No. 438 of 2023 is treated as on the day's list.

The applications (AP No. 445 of 2023 and AP No. 438 of 2023) are dismissed as withdrawn.

The appeal (APOT 300 of 2023) and the stay application (IA No. GA 1 of 2023) are disposed of.

As affidavits have not been invited, allegations contained in the stay application are deemed not to have been admitted.
