The Court: This is an application under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The petitioner prays for extension of mandate of the learned arbitrator by a period of one year. The arbitration is at the stage of cross-examination of the respondent's witnesses.

Learned advocate for the respondent submits that baseless allegations have been made against the respondent.
