ORDER

In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the order dated 24th May, 2023, issued by the respondent authority by virtue of which he had been compulsory retired from the services.

Today, when the case came up for consideration, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance on the order dated 30.08.2024, passed by the Sr. DSC- Railway Protection Force, Northern Railway Hazrat Gunj Lucknow, whereby the order dated 24th May, 2024, impugned in the instant petition stands revoked by the respondent-authority. However, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is only now aggrieved of the period w.e.f. 23.05.2023 to 30.08. 2024 which has been treated as *dies-non*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the impugned order stands revoked by the respondents, as such, he does not want to pursue the instant petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is *dismissed* as not pressed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate remedy with regard to period i.e., 23.05.2023 to 30.08. 2024 that has been treated as *dies-non*.
