2. The instant C.M.P. application has been filed for restoration of L.P.A. No. 273 of 2016 which stood dismissed for non-compliance of this Court's order dated 31.07.2017 presided over Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ratnaker Bhengra.
