This civil miscellaneous petition has been filed for restoration of MA No. 59 of 2011 which was dismissed in default on 12th April 2013 for non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 5th April 2013.

2. However, this petition for restoration has been filed on 20th December 2017. Not only an application under section 5 of the Limitation Act 1963 has not been filed along with the present restoration petition, the petitioner has infact alleged gross laches on the part of the conducting Advocate.

3. In the aforementioned fact, I find no ground to entertain this restoration petition and, according, CMP No. 493 of 2017 is dismissed.
