1. The present writ petition has been filed for the following reliefs :-

2. On the instruction of the client, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to work out his remedy in accordance with law.
3. Learned counsel for the Union of India/ respondents has no objection.
4. Permission is granted.
5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is, hereby, dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
6. Pending interlocutory application, if any, also stands disposed of.
