3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition with the following prayer:

“In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner most humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this petition, issue notice to the Opp.parties, and after hearing the parties be pleased to direct the Opposite Parties to regularize the shop premises of the petitioner by allotting and settled a piece of land in the new railway market in his favour on any terms and conditions for the ends of justice.”
