2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. The petitioners have filed this writ petition with the following prayer:

“It is therefore, prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this Writ Petition, issue RULE NISI calling upon the Opposite Parties to show cause as to why the Opp. Parties will not initiate land acquisition proceeding and pay adequate compensation to the petitioners for taking railway line and fixing cable wire over rayati lands under Annexure-1 Series and provide alternative agricultural lands and if the opposite parties fail to show cause or show insufficient cause, the said rule be made absolute in granting the reliefs prayed for.”

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already made representation before Opposite Party No.3 vide Annexure-4, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time.

5. Considering the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits



of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.3 to consider and dispose of the representation filed by the petitioners vide Annexure-4 and pass appropriate order as early as possible within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
