01. 1. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and the State.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner prays
for the following relief:-

“It is therefore, most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be graciously be pleased to admit this writ application and issue rule NISI calling upon the Opp. Parties to show cause as to why the impugned order of transfer dated 07-11-2024 vide Letter No. 2024/Sec (E)/TR-2/3 (9) under Annexure -6 so far it relates to the



petitioner shall not be quashed by allowing him to continue in the present place of posting.

And

If the opposite parties fail to show cause or show insufficient of cause, issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned order of transfer Dtd. 07-11-2024 so far it relates to the petitioner as Annexed under Annexure-6.

And

And further issue a writ in Mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing the Opp. Parties not to disturb the petitioner from his present place of posting till completion of his normal tenure of 3 years.

And

Pass such further writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions as may be deemed fit and proper for the above fact of case as your Lordships deem just and proper.”

3. It is submitted by Mr. Padhi, learned counsel for the Union of India that the Petitioner has already joined in his place of posting under annexure-6 and virtually this Writ Petition is infructuous. However, it is submitted by



learned counsel for the Petitioner that subsequent to the posting and joining of the Petitioner, he has also made a representation before the Authority for reconsideration of the transfer back to his earlier place of posting in view of the fact that within a period of eleven months, he has been transferred thrice.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, since the Petitioner has already joined in his place of posting, the Director General, Railway Protection Force, Rail Bhawan, New Delhi i.e. Opposite Party No.1 is directed to consider the representation of the Petitioner in accordance with law. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
