1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. The application has been filed by the Petitioner for modification of the order dated 20.12.2024 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.32300 of 2024.
3. Heard.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that this Writ Petition has been disposed of by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2024 directing the Petitioner to approach the Appellate Authority by filing an appeal under Section 211 of the Railways Protection Force Rules, 1987 with a stipulated period. In fact, the Senior



Divisional Security Commissioner, RPF/ E.Co.Rly/ Waltair is the Appellate Authority. Therefore, the words "Appellate Authority" mentioned in Paragraphs-5, 6 and 7 of the aforesaid order may be specified as "Senior Divisional Security Commissioner, RPF/ E.Co.Rly/ Waltair".

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the averments made in the I.A., prayer is allowed. Accordingly, it is directed that the words "Appellate Authority" mentioned in Paragraphs-5, 6 and 7 of the aforesaid order be read as "Senior Divisional Security Commissioner, RPF/ E.Co.Rly/ Waltair"

6. In view of the aforesaid modification, the time stipulated for filing of the appeal by the Petitioner is extended for a further period of fifteen working days from today.

7. This order shall be read as a part of the original order. All other parts of the original order shall remain unaltered.

8. Accordingly, the I.A. is disposed of.
