ORDER

Shri Devesh Bhojne, learned counsel for the respondent No.1 submits that Coordinate Bench of this Court in Writ Petition No.764 of 2023 decided on 01.09.2023 (Poonam Patel v. Union of India and Others) has taken into consideration law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case of ***L. Chandra Kumar v. Union of India, (1997) 3 SCC 261*** and directed the petitioner therein to approach the Central Administrative Tribunal.

In the present case, since Annexure P-7 pertains to appointment in the Pay-band 1, Rs.15200 - 20200, with Grade Pay of 1800/- on account of acquisition of land. The petitioner has a remedy before the Central Administrative Tribunal, in view of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in *L. Chandra Kumar (supra)*. Therefore, the petitioner is relegated to avail said remedy before the appropriate Tribunal.

In the above terms, the petition is disposed of.
