PER COURT :-

1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant, the learned A.P.P. for the respondent and the victim-in-person.
2. The applicant was granted temporary bail. During that period, the applicant married the victim. She has on her own sworn in an affidavit before the Court that there was minor dispute between them. Since they were from the different caste, there was some misunderstanding and out of it, the report was lodged and crime was registered. She has no objection for granting regular bail to the applicant. Both the applicant and the victim are present in the Court. The statement has been made on behalf of the applicant that they got married. The victim-in-person who is present in the Court also admits that she married the applicant. She was major at the time of the incident. It was her consensual

decision to be with the applicant. In these peculiar circumstances, the order granting temporary bail deserves to be confirmed. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

- i) Bail application is allowed.
- ii) The order granting bail dated 19.01.2024 stands confirmed.
