PER COURT :-

1. After hearing learned advocate for the applicant and learned A.P.P. for the State, when this court expressed disinclination to allow the application, learned advocate for the applicant, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this application.

2. Leave granted. The application is disposed of as withdrawn.

3. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that if the charge is not framed within a year from the date of registration of crime, the applicant be granted liberty to file an application for bail before the appropriate court.

4. The trial court to note that if the charge is not framed within one year the applicant is at liberty to file such application for bail

before the appropriate court.

5. Needless to mention, the applicant is expected to cooperate with the trial court for framing of charge and conducting the trial.
