PER COURT :-

1. After hearing learned advocate for the applicant and learned A.P.P. for the respondent-State, when the court expressed disinclination to allow this application, learned advocate for the applicant, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this application.

2. Leave granted. The application is disposed of as withdrawn.

3. During the course of arguments, it is revealed that the informant is financially suffering, as her husband is behind bars, who was maintaining her and the victim girl. Both are victims of the crime. In so far as the financial condition of the informant is concerned and the fact that she is suffering from the illness of tuberculosis, the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Jalgaon is requested to provide financial assistance under various schemes to the informant

and the victim girl, as early as possible, if it is not already provided.

4. The Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Jalgaon is also directed to get the monetary relief from the concerned Tahsildar, Chalisgaon, district Jalgaon under various welfare schemes, available for the children below the age of 18 years like *Eklavya Yojna* and *Shravan Bal Yojna* etc. for the informant, who is practically disabled so that the victim in this case will get financial support.

5. Registry to forward the copies of this order to the Tahsildar, Chalisgaon, district Jalgaon so also to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Jalgaon, as early as possible.
