ORDER :

- (II) Order dated 29.12.2023, passed by learned Sessions Judge, Hingli, in Bail Application No. 658 of 2023, is hereby quashed and set aside.
- (III) Appellants be released on bail in connection with Crime No. 566 of 2023, registered with Hingoli Rural Police Station, Dist. Hingoli, for offences punishable under sections 302, 323, 143, 147, 148, 149, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and under section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va), 3(2)(v) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, on executing P.B. and S.B. of Rs. 15,000/- each, with one surety in the like amount.
- (IV) Appellants shall not influence the prosecution witnesses.
