1. The Petitioners have no personal interest in the cause raised in this Petition. No legal injuries are caused to them. They have filed an application dated 28.12.2022 purportedly under section 40 of the Waqf Act, 1995 without mentioning any provisions or the Act under which an inquiry is sought.
