These civil applications are for condonation of delay of 19
days in preferring applications for Review.

2. By common order dated 05.12.2023, three Writ Petitions were disposed of. The applicants have filed Review Applications along with applications for delay.

Considering the explanation stated in paragraph nos. 3 and 4 of the application for condonation of delay, I am inclined to allow the applications.
