ORDER :

- 1 Leave to amend. Amendment to be carried out immediately.
- 2 Issue notice to the respondents. Learned AGP waives notice of respondent Nos.1 and 2.
- 3 The matter can be disposed of as the petitioner is seeking direction to respondent No.2 to decide his caste claim.
- 4 The learned AGP, on instructions, makes a statement that respondent No.2 would decide the claim within a period of six months from

today. The said statement is taken as undertaking.

5 The writ petition stands disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the caste claim of the petitioner within a period of six months from today.

6 Learned Advocate for the petitioner to file appropriate Vakalatnama within a period of one week and to deposit costs of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) to the Library of Bar Association of Bombay High Court at Aurangabad, within one week.
