1. Heard.
2. The Petitioners have a statutory remedy available before the Debt Recovery Tribunal. The order dated 7th February, 2024 passed by the learned Tribunal in Diary No. 1059/2023 indicates that the Petitioner was permitted to file a fresh securitisation application in case he is aggrieved by the action of the Respondent. The Respondent was ready to accept Rs. 88 Lacs as a 'one time settlement', if paid within 15 days. Since the Petitioners did not do so, the offer is withdrawn.

3. In view of the above, **this Writ Petition is disposed off** with liberty as is permissible in law.
