PER COURT:

1. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner submits that the representation of the Petitioner, dated 13/12/2023, addressed to the Divisional Commissioner, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar may be decided.

2. The learned A.G.P. submits that the said representation of the Petitioner would be dealt with within a reasonable time.
