PER COURT :-

1. While allowing the Civil Application No. 4042 of 2022 on 24th June, 2022, we have observed in paragraph No. 5 that the Petitioner can file an affidavit undertaking along with her Application for withdrawal. For clarity, paragraph No. 5 reproduced hereunder:

"5. As such, the applicant would withdraw an amount of Rs. 1,50,000/-, which is the residual amount in light of paragraph No.5 of the order dated 06.03.2020. Needless to state, the petitioner/applicant shall file an affidavit undertaking alongwith her application for withdrawal, stating therein that if she is subsequently held dis-entitled to the entire amount withdrawn or to any portion thereof, she would return that excess that amount by depositing the same in this Court within 8 (eight) weeks from such adverse order."

2. By this Civil Application, the Petitioner prays that the affidavit would be sworn/affirmed before the Superintendent of the District Court,

Hingoli and that would be produced through the Advocate in the registry of this Court. The said request is granted. **The Civil Application is disposed off.** Needless to state, the Registrar of this Court shall accept the said affidavit undertaking along with an Application for withdrawal of amount and a copy of the Adhar card of the Applicant.
