PER COURT :-

1. Pending application of the Petitioner for seeking Section 44 N.A. permission, is pending since January 2021.
2. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner submits that if the application is not decided within 90 days, it would be deemed to have been granted.
3. The learned AGP submits that the pending application would be decided within such timeline as this Court may direct.

4. Considering the passage of three years and six months, we direct the District Collector, Jalgaon, to deal with the application of the Petitioner, within 60 days from today. We would not grant an extension of even a single day. The entire procedure, shall be scrupulously followed.
