Learned A.G.P. respondent No.1 State and learned Advocate
Mr. Sangle for respondent No.2.

2. The applicant has preferred first appeal against the
judgment and order/ award dated 16/12/2011, passed by the
Reference Court. Since there is delay of 06 days in filing the
appeal, this application is preferred for condonation of delay.
The applicant has stated the reasons for the delay in
paragraph No.5 of the applications, which are as follows :-
