1. The Petitioner, Original Defendant No.2 in Regular Civil Suit No.142/2016, prays that the suit be decided within a stipulated period.
2. It is well settled that a Writ of Mandamus to a Judicial officer cannot be issued, unless in rare and exceptional circumstances. So also, there are several litigants who are in queue before the Court. Merely because the Petitioner has preferred a Writ Petition for directions, would not warrant issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to the learned Judge to decide the suit out of turn.
3. In view of the above, **this Writ Petition is disposed off.** The learned Judge would deal with RCS No.142/2016 in queue with filing of cases considering the date of the lodging of this case.
