PER COURT :-

1. The applicants/original claimants are seeking to condone the delay of 664 days caused in filing the appeal against the award passed by the Tribunal under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act.
2. Heard Mr Ghatol Patil, learned advocate appearing for the applicants and Mr. Usmanpurkar, learned advocate appearing for respondent no.2.
3. Having considered the submissions advanced and the reasons as stated in paragraph nos.2 to 6 of the application, the case is made out to condone the delay. Hence, civil application is allowed. Delay of 664 days caused in filing the appeal is condoned. Civil application stands disposed off.
