ORDER :-

This is an application for restoration of Criminal Application No.4585 of 2023, which was dismissed in default, by condoning delay of 96 days in preferring this application.

2. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned APP waives notice for respondent no.1. It is informed by learned counsel for the applicant that the whereabouts of respondent no.2 – informant, who had given consent for quashing the FIR are not known. We, therefore, appoint Mr.Nilesh N. Bhagwat, learned counsel, to represent respondent no.2.

3. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (B) and (C). Delay condoned. Criminal Application No.4585 of 2023 stands restored to file.
