2. Petitioner's request for correction in the school record has
been rejected by the impugned communication by the respondent No.3

Education Officer (Primary), precisely on the ground that it has not been rooted through proper channel.

3. Learned advocate for the respondent No.4 – Headmaster submits that the headmaster would forward the proposal to the Education Officer within a week. We accept the statement as an undertaking to the Court and dispose of the writ petition by directing the headmaster to forward the proposal within a week and thereafter the respondent No.3 – Education Officer to decide it on its own merits in the light of **Janabai d/o. Himmatrao Thakur Vs. State of Maharashtra and Ors.;2019 (6) Mh.L.J. 769**. It shall not be rejected only on the ground that the petitioner had left the school. The Education Officer shall take the decision, as expeditiously as possible and in any case within four weeks from receipt of the proposal of the headmaster.
