ORDER :

It is a matter of reimbursement of fees in respect of 25% students admitted by the petitioner management under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

2. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned advocate Ms. Chintamani waives notice for respondent no. 1. Learned AGP waives notice for respondents no. 2 to 4 – State and learned advocate Mr. Suryawanshi waives notice for respondent no. 5.

3. We have heard both the sides.

4. We dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents to undertake scrutiny of the petitioners independently on its own merits and take appropriate decision as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within a period of four (4) weeks from today and if they are found entitled to get reimbursement, shall disburse the money to them within a period of four (4) weeks thereafter.
