PER COURT :

The petitioner who is father of deceased-employee who had died unmarried is claiming to receive DCPS benefit.

2. The petitioner's application seems to be pending with the respondent authorities. Though the applicant seems to possess heirship certificate issued under Bombay Regulation of 1827, it is a blanket one without any reference to the instant claim.

3. We dispose of the writ petition by expecting the petitioner to obtain a succession certificate under Section 372 of the Indian Succession

Act and apply again. If any such application together with succession certificate is filed it shall be considered as expeditiously as possible and in any case within three (03) weeks of filling of the application.
