1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned APP for respondent-State and learned counsel for the contesting respondent bank.
2. The applicant has been arrested under non-bailable warrant, for his default in attending the trial. The findings of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Nandurbar are that many a times, the non-bailable warrants were issued against the applicant.
