ORDER :

1. Heard learned Advocate for the applicants and learned Advocate for respondent No.2.

2. Respondent No.2 has filed the affidavit-in-reply informing that there is settlement. The affidavit giving details which is sworn before the Notary has also been produced. Respondent No.2 has given no objection for quashing the FIR. Hence, we are

of the opinion that case is made out for exercising the powers of this Court under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

3. The application stands allowed.

The FIR vide Crime No.200 of 2024 dated 27.06.2024 registered with Ramanand Nagar Police Station, Taluka and District Jalgaon for the offence punishable under Section 420 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, stands quashed and set aside, subject to deposit of cost of Rs.10,000/- each by the applicants within a period of one week to the High Court Legal Service Sub Committee, Aurangabad.
