3 Considering the amount, the following order is passed:

ORDER

I. Applicants Uttam, Raosaheb and Ushabai are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount of compensation alongwith accrued interest on furnishing usual undertaking. They are further permitted to withdraw 25% of the amount alongwith accrued interest on furnishing solvent surety / security to the satisfaction of the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. The remaining amount be kept in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank till disposal of the appeal.

II. So far as applicant Vitthal is concerned, he is permitted to withdraw the entire amount alongwith accrued interest on furnishing usual undertaking.

III. The amount be transferred in their individual accounts.

IV. With this, the civil application stands disposed of.
