PER COURT :-

1. The applicants seek to condone the delay of 54 days caused in filing the appeal against the award passed by the Tribunal under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act.

2. Heard Mr Shaikh, learned advocate appearing for the applicants and Mr. Kulkarni, learned advocate appearing for the respondent no.1.

3. Having considered the submissions and grounds for condonation of delay as stated in paragraph nos.2 to 4 of the application, sufficient cause is made out to condone the delay.
