PER COURT :-

1. The learned Advocate for the Petitioners submits that out of the eight Petitioners, six have tendered their caste certificates. Copies of the caste certificates of the remaining two Petitioners is placed on record. Both are collectively marked as "X-1", for identification.

2. In view of the above and considering paragraph 9 of the order of this Court dated 24.06.2024, delivered in Civil

Application No.15434 of 2023 in Writ Petition No.3950 of 2023, the fourth Respondent will have to consider the proposals of these Petitioners for compassionate appointment, on their own merits.

3. The learned Advocate representing the Corporation submits that the proposals would be scrutinized and would be considered within a reasonable period of time.

4. In view of the above, **this Writ Petition is disposed off** with a direction to the Corporation to consider their claims/proposals, for compassionate appointment in the light of the above referred order dated 24.06.2024, delivered in Civil Application No.15434 of 2023, within a period of 60 days.
